






Prime Age Workers Labor Force Participation for 25-54 Years Old


China's Unstable Demographics

Population by Age and Gender, People's Republic of China (in Millions)




European DemographicsPopulation by Age and Gender, European Union (in Millions)





Demographic Transition


Population by Age and Gender, United States of America (in Millions)



Idaho's Population Structure


Population by Age and Gender, State of Idaho (in Thousands)






The Labor Death Cross

People Turning 65 vs those Turning 18 by year






Annual Working Age Population Growth by Decade
